 - b: 156 Washington – Eloise Hudson c/o Michell Brown - House – \$4,140.00 to condemn – She first told us not to touch it, that she would have it torn down herself; now she has decided that she is going to remodel it instead. Chief and I stopped by there last week, and she has already started work on the house and property.
 - c: As of now, the only homes on the condemned list are: 490 Washington, 150 Garner Lane and 1360 E. Mississippi Ave.
