Special Called Session

The Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Many met in special session, Friday, May 24, 2024 at 12:30 pm. at Town Hall. Present were Mayor Robert H. Hable, Jr. and Council Members Mayor Pro Tem Bobbie Jackson, Mary Perry, Anita Darwin, Cherry Williams and Mary Brocato. Also present were Town Clerk Amie Brown, Chief of Police Cheryl Wooley and Asst. Chief Mason Wiley.

The purpose of the meeting:

Amend Budget to allow Police Dept. to purchase two used vehicles for \$20,000 from City of Ponchatoula** – Mayor Hable stated the reason for the meeting is because the units were not budgeted but the police department is in need of them per Chief Wooley and it was also pointed out that per our financial statement from April the Law Enforcement budget year-to-date is to the good \$212,307 so Chief Wooley has been doing great watching her expenses. Chief Wooley stated the units requesting to be purchased are a 2017 Ford Explorer with 64,000 miles for \$10,000 and a 2015 Ford Explorer with 66,000 miles for \$10,000 and we have two older units that we are replacing them with.

Next scheduled Regular Council Meeting is on Tuesday, June 18, 2024.

Meeting adjourned with a motion by Jackson; seconded by Brocato. Motion passed unanimously.
