

**ORDINANCE #10 OF 2018**

**AMENDING ORDINANCE - "UTILITIES"**  
**ARTICLE II. WATER**  
**SEC. 20-20**  
**WATER TAPPING**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MANY, SABINE PARISH, LOUISIANA, at a regularly scheduled meeting held on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2018, upon motion by Corley and a second by Jackson, to add section 20-20, the following ordinance was introduced:

Section 20 of Chapter 20 "Utilities", Article II, "Water," be amended to include the following:

All costs and expense incident to the installation and connection of the building water shall be borne by the owner. The owner shall indemnify the town from any loss or damage that may directly or indirectly be occasioned by the installation of the building water. The town shall cause its water line to be within three-hundred (300) feet of the property line of any customer, within the town limits, desiring water services.

The above ordinance having been duly introduced at a regular meeting of the Aldermen on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2018 was put to a vote by the Mayor, and the vote was recorded as follows with a motion by Corley; seconded by Jackson.
