

ORDINANCE #3 OF 2018

AMENDING ORDINANCE - "UTILITIES" **ARTICLE III. SEWERS, SEWAGE AND SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL** **DIVISION 1. GENERALLY, SEC. 20-34 (b)** **CUSTOMER SEWER MAINTENANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MANY, SABINE PARISH, LOUISIANA, at a regularly scheduled meeting held on the 17th day of April, 2018, upon motion by Peterson and a second by Kennedy, to add section (b), the following ordinance was introduced:

- (b) A person shall not directly or indirectly discharge, or allow to be discharged, the contents or effluent from any plumbing fixtures, vault, privy, portable toilet, or septic tank, into any road, street, gutter, ditch, water course, body of water, or onto the surface of the ground.

At the point of notification of raw sewage dumping on the ground as a result of a defect in the property owners sewer line we are to take the following actions:

- 1.) Post a notice on the door of the home notifying the problem and give 48 hours to notify City Hall with a solution to the problem
- 2.) Mail a certified letter notifying the property owner of the situation giving them 10 days from receipt of the letter to correct the problem
- 3.) After the specified period of time and the problem is not corrected the problem will be turned over to the health unit
- 4.) If the customer does not comply with the health unit their water will be disconnected

The above ordinance having been duly introduced at a regular meeting of the Aldermen on the 17th day of April, 2018 was put to a vote by the Mayor, and the vote was recorded as follows with a motion by Peterson; seconded by Kennedy.
