RESOLUTION NO. 7 OF 2022

TITLE: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO COMPLETE, SIGN, AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A GRANT OF FUNDS FROM THE LOUISIANA COMMUNITY WATER ENRICHMENT FUND (CWEF); TO SIGN REQUEST FOR PAYMENT (RFP)

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Board of Aldermen for the Town of Many, Parish of Sabine, State of Louisiana, wish to apply for a grant of funds from the Louisiana Community Water Enrichment Fund (CWEF)

WHEREAS, the CWEF will be used for inspection, rehabilitation, and purchases of new pump and aerator for the Andries Street Well to reconnect back into the Town of Many Water Distribution System

WHEREAS, the inspection and rehabilitation of Andries Street Well will directly impact the residents by improving the quantity of water the Town of Many Water Distribution System can produce within established guidelines for the safety and sanitary conditions associated with water distribution

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Aldermen, in due and regular legal session convened, this 17th day of May, 2022, they do hereby authorize and fully support: the application for CEWF funds in the amount of \$35,000, and to authorize the Mayor of the Town to execute the application; authorize the Mayor to sign for Request for Payments (RFP); authorize Suzanne Williams, Contract Grant Writer for the Town of Many, to certify signatures as needed for reimbursements;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

On motion of the Alderman Williams, seconded by Alderman Perry, this resolution was duly adopted this 17th day of May 2022, by unanimous voice vote.


